

"Sguardi sui territori", the Festival on Visual anthropology and ecomuseums, returns: the IV edition is scheduled from October 5 to 8 2023. Held in Udine, Gemona del Friuli, Buja and Montenars, it will be dedicated to **territorial research projects** carried out in Basilicata, Veneto, Sardinia and Friuli Venezia Giulia, which have resulted in ethnographic investigations, field surveys, creation of audiovisual documentation, data collection, cataloging of tangible and intangible assets, cultural itineraries; it will give space to **regional and national museums** that have competed with the audiovisual representation of their territories and communities; it will present a retrospective of **Libero Bizzari**, a figure who made the history of documentary filmmaking in Italy. Research institutes, associations, ecomuseums and ethnographic museums participate in the festival, represented by anthropologists, historians, architects, geographers, archivists and documentary filmmakers.

The main theme of the Festival is **landscape**, conceived starting from the definition coined by the European Convention - *'Landscape' designates a specific part of the territory, as it is perceived by the populations, whose character derives from the action of natural and/or human factors and by their interrelationships* - but also articulated within contemporary dynamics: climate change and the consequent transformations of places and activities, the intersections between man and nature, abandonments, returns, the dialectical processes between tradition and innovation, replacements and intergenerational exchanges, pacts and conflicts between different territorial interests.
